COMMENTS:

COURT notes mediation was set for 9/15/2017 but attorney Pollock's client is not available.

POLLOCK indicates they are available the week of 9/25/2017 but not 9/26; or the week of 10/2/2017 but not 10/2.

PAGEL is available the week of 9/25.

COURT re-sets mediation for 9/27/2017.

Counsel agree to leave the remaining deadlines related to mediation as scheduled.

COURT will enter a revised /amended order to issue only a new date as to mediation.

Mediation Hearing re-set for September 27, 2017 at 9:00 a.m. (all day set aside). The parties should also be available the entire day. Prior to the hearing on:

- (1) 8/25/2017 – plaintiff to submit a written settlement demand to the defendants; it should be a compromise number;
- (2) 9/1/2017 – defendants to respond to plaintiff's written settlement demand; it should be a compromise number;
- (3) All parties to also include non-monetary terms in their written settlement demands;
- (4) 9/11/2017 – each party send to court ex-parte:
 - a. Mediation letter not to exceed 5 pages single-spaced setting forth their positions;
 - b. Separate ex-parte letter that includes facts or information that would be helpful to the court for the mediation hearing;
 - c. Plaintiff's counsel shall also submit to court the first two initial letters.
